Bulgaria will add over 2,500 MW of installed renewable power capacity by the end of 2024 through the installation of 700 MW of wind farms, 1,600 MW of solar parks, and 219 MW of biomass-fired power ...

In 2019 Bulgaria had 708 MW of wind power capacity, with the European Wind Energy Association stating that Bulgaria has the potential to generate up to 3.4 GW of wind power.

By 2024, Bulgaria had 242 hydropower plants, accounting for 8 percent of total electricity generation in 2022. More significant, numerous coal-fired power stations were built during this period, thanks to the ...
