Design patents have a term of fourteen years from the date of patent grant, except for any design patent issued from applications filed on or after May 13, 2015 (the date of entry into force ...

Generally speaking, the term of a U.S. utility patent begins on the date the patent issues and expires on the date that is 20 years from the date that the application was originally filed.

Utility patents are granted to cover the functional aspects of inventions for a period of 20 years, while design patents preserve the aesthetic appearance of products for a duration of 15 years.
