With a percentage of 55%, plug-in hybrid vehicles became the most sold type of new car in Iceland last year, 2021. It is also the first time in Icelandic history that vehicles fueled by gasoline or diesel make ...

In 2022, the market share of battery electric vehicles (BEV) was 33% and plug-in hybrid electric vehicles (PHEV) was 23%. This brings Iceland's plug-in market share to just under 56%, the second highest ...

Effective January 1, 2026, Iceland introduced a new per-kilometer road tax applicable to all vehicles, spanning electric and plug-in hybrid (PHEV) models as well as traditional petrol and diesel cars.

The adoption of plug-in electric vehicles in Iceland is the second highest in the world after Norway, and fully
