What does EN stand for in a PV module?

Standard (EN), published in 2003, details the information that manufacturers must supply with a PV module. The EN requires manufacturers to report module data (voltage, current, and power at maximum power point, Voc, and Isc) at standard test conditions (STC), nominal operating open-circuit voltage (V_{oc}), and nominal operating open-circuit current (I_{sc}).

The power class is a way to classify the variations of the same model based on their wattage or power rating. Solar panels within the same power class are designed to have similar power output characteristics, efficiency levels, and electrical performance.

How are solar PV panels rated?

The efficiency ranges for star rating are decided based on the analysis of more than two hundred PV panels across from thirteen PV panel manufacturers. Currently, 60% of the PV panels are spread across 3-star and 4-star ratings (see Table 5). Solar PV panels are covered under CRS (Compulsory Registration Scheme).
