Research Institutes like NREL have estimated that appropriate degradation rates of solar panels can be set at 0.5% per year with current technology. Do solar panels lose efficiency as time goes on?

This doesn't alter the fact that solar panels do lose efficiency as time goes on. There are two main reasons for this. The first is that continuous exposure to the sun's ultraviolet rays cause degradation in the solar cells, which in turn decreases the power output of the system.
